Note of Douzaine Decisions made following email consultation on 20th April 2020.
The scheduled Douzaine meeting could not take place because of restrictions of movement because of the coronavirus pandemic.

Decisions made on 23 rd March 2020	The note confirming the decisions made by remote meeting on 23 rd March 2020 was agreed with no amendments.	
2020 Owners and Refuse Rates.	<p>At the March meeting (held remotely) the Douzaine had confirmed a decision made previously, that the owner's rates for 2020 should be £104,781 (£75,950 secular and £28,831 ecclesiastical) and that the refuse rate should be £120,000, and that the Constables should apply to the Royal Court for permission to levy the rates in 2020.</p> <p>The ecclesiastical rate had been agreed following consultation with the Church Property Management Board.</p> <p>In accordance with Statutory Instrument 'The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Parochial Matters and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations 2020, a notice detailing the proposed owner's and refuse rates for 2020 was posted on the parish website (stsaviours.gg/douzaine) on 6th April 2020. The same notice was published in La Gazette Officielle on 8th April 2020.</p> <p>Details of the Constables' and Church Property Management Board's financial accounts for the year ending on 31st December 2019 has also been made available for inspection on the parish website (posted on 6th April 2020).</p> <p>Ratepayers wishing to make comment about the proposed rates for 2020 were invited to do so by writing to the Constables, either by post or email before 17th April 2020.</p> <p>The Constables received no comments at all.</p> <p>The Douzaine met remotely (electronically by email) on 20th April 2020 and unanimously determined that the Constables should proceed with the application and request permission from the Court to levy the rates in 2020.</p>
