Douzaine meeting could not take place because of restrictions of movement because
of the coronavirus pandemic.

| Minutes of meeting held on 24 th February 2020 | The minutes were agreed with no amendments. | |
| Secular Remede for 2020 | At the February meeting the Douzaine had approved the Secular Remede for 2020 in the sum of £107,710. Subsequently (following email consultation) it was agreed (by majority, - 9 in favour, 2 against and 1 abstention) to reduce this figure to £75,950 (a reduction of £31,760) in recognition that the current coronavirus outbreak might present a financial burden on ratepayers. The deferred matters would have to be addressed in future years. | |
| Ecclesiastical Remede for 2020 | The Church Property Management Board (CPMB) had previously provided the Constables with documents that indicated the sum of the Ecclesiastical Remede for 2020 would be £51,814. Subsequently this figure was reduced (by the CPMB) to £28,831 (a reduction of £22,983) in recognition that the current coronavirus outbreak might present a financial burden on ratepayers. The deferred matters would have to be addressed in future years. | |
| Refuse Remede for 2020 | The Refuse Remede for 2020 (£120k) had been agreed at the February meeting. The contract in place for collection of household waste dictates the sum needed to provide this service to ratepayers. | |
| SSCC Building Maintenance | The Directors had been due to report to the Douzaine concerning the maintenance plans for the buildings that comprise St Saviour's Community Centre (SSCC). In the absence of this, the Directors were asked to provide the Constables with a written report detailing the building maintenance that is planned, together with an indicated cost and, hopefully, an assurance that the LBG has sufficient funds available for the work. Subsequently, the Directors have confirmed that they are working on a report but because of restrictions of movement it is proving difficult to complete until building firms were properly back at work. | |
| Bornement | An application for a Bornement in respect of work to be carried out at La Grande Rue was approved. | |
| Parochial Cemetery | The Cemetery Committee had revised the rules concerning the operation of the parochial cemetery and these had been circulated to Douzeniers for approval. There were no suggested changes and all confirmed that the rules should be amended as drafted. | |
| Douzaine Liaison Group | The notes from the most recent meeting had been circulated to members for their information. | |
| Future Meetings | Because of the current restrictions on social distancing, it is not likely that Douzaine meetings will be able to take place in the short term. Neither is it likely that the planned parish meeting for 20 th April will take place. The States are investigating the provision of emergency regulations that will allow for the annual parish rates to be levied. | |
