Electors Election Meeting (with 15 electors present) held at St Saviours Community Centre on Wednesday 3rd November 2021 at 7pm.

The Electors met to elect three Douzeniers to serve until 31st December 2025, one Douzenier to service until 31st December 2024, one Constable to serve until 31st December 2024 and a parish representative to serve on La Mare de Carteret High School Committee until 31st December 2024.

Mr Neil Le Poidevin (NLP) (Senior Constable) acted as Returning Officer for the election of Douzeniers and La Mare de Carteret High School Committee Representative.

NLP explained that there were four candidates for four vacant Douzenier positions; -

John Louis Gillson proposed by Renaut Anthony Victor de Garis and seconded by Judith Marguerite Gillson

Peter Raymond Harris proposed by Alison Jane Vine and seconded by Elizabeth Anne Pirouet-Douglas

Sophie Marguerite Betty Roughsedge proposed by Robert Colin Murray and seconded by Fiona Louise Elliott

Susan Mary Watson proposed by Adrian David Machon and seconded by Darrel Mark Bertrand

NLP invited the candidates to introduce themselves.

NLP then declared (since the number of candidates was not greater than the number of vacancies) that Messrs. Gillson and Harris and Ms Watson were duly elected to serve as Douzeniers until 31st December 2025 with Mrs. Roughsedge to serve for a three-year period until 31st December 2024.

NLP advised the meeting that there were no nominations for parish representative on La Mare de Carteret High School committee.

Mr RAV de Garis (RdG) then explained to the meeting that (as Dean of the Douzaine) it is his responsibility to act as Returning Officer for the election of the position of Constable.

He then explained that there was one candidate for one vacant position of Constable; -

John Louis Gillson proposed by Geoffrey Chapman and seconded by Michelle Mary Scott.

RdG invited Mr Gillson to introduce himself.

RdG declared (since the number of candidates was not greater than the number of vacancies) that John Louis Gillson was duly elected to serve as Constable until 31st December 2024.

RdG on behalf of the Parish thanked NLP for his service as Constable for five years.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 7.03pm.
