Apologies	There were no apologies.				
Minutes of Meeting held on 27 th March 2023	The minutes were agreed and signed by the Constable.				
Matters Arising	There were no matters arising.				
Douzaine Council	KF advised that a meeting would take place on 27 April 2023 where the future of the Douzaine Council would be discussed. It was noted that Parishes had different views on whether it should continue or not.				
Parish Working Group	RM advised that E & I had attended the meeting and answered a range of questions. He would circulate the minutes in due course.				
Church Property Management Board	It was noted that there has been some discussion with the various parishes and the Law Officers concerning the Composition of Church Management Board after their production of a Parish Manual. The manual stated that the Legislation does not provide for a Church Management Board to hold funds. Clarification on this point had been sought and although the legislation is otherwise silent on this matter it was the general view that the Management Boards should not hold funds.				
	After discussion it was agreed that the funds currently held by the Management Board within the Preservation Contingency Fund should be moved under the control of the Constables. It was noted that the remaining funds held by the Management Board had been approved by the Douzaine and would be utilized within a 12 month timeframe.				
Food Waste	PC advised that the email with the subject 'A better and cheaper way to deal with parish food waste' from Deputy Meerveld has been circulated. Deputy Meerveld advised that this company was excluded from the current waste contract tendering process due to the criteria imposed. Guernsey Waste would not share the tender information with us as it was a closed process.				
	The Douzaine expressed concern regarding this approach from a Deputy. It was agreed that a response would be sent to advise that we would continue to deal				

	with Guernsey Waste.	
Any other	KF advised that the work would soon commence on the Cemetery wall. It was	
business	noted that Traffic had advised that a 3 way traffic light system would be in place	
	for the duration.
